English

Our first book this half term is 'The day the crayons came home' by Drew Daywalt. We will be writing stories about events inspired by this book. Our second book is 'The journey home' by Fran Preston-Gannon which will inspire some nonchronological report writing.

Little Wandle phonics lessons will also continue 4 days a week, along with reading our Author of the Month books each day.

Maths

In maths this half term we will be applying our number skills and exploring multiplication and division. We will be using objects to solve problems and exploring how multiplication and division facts are related.



PSHE

We'll be learning about 'My space'. In this topic, we are focussing on what parts of our bodies are public and private. We will be learning what private means and how to keep parts of our bodies private. We will also be learning how to stay safe by exploring who is safe to speak to when we are sad or uncomfortable.

Art and Design

Our art sessions this half term will be based around 'Natural material printing'. We will be looking at famous prints inspired by nature, including the work of William Morris. We will also be making our own prints using different methods.

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Computing

In partnership with our friends from the Ridge primary, we will be learning about 'Algorithms', using BeeBots to explore sequences of commands and programming.

Geography

Building on our previous learning, we are going to be exploring the countries that make up the United Kingdom and learning a little about the people, places and cultures of each member of the UK.

Science

We will be exploring plants and growing. We will be building on our learning in horticulture to dive into greater detail about what plants need to survive, how plants grow and even growing some of our own!

Integration

We are lucky to have continuing visits from our local mainstream Primary school. Our friends from the Ridge Primary will be visiting us on Thursdays to help us with our learning as part of our shared integration.

PE

We are very lucky to have cricket sessions with a cricket coach this half term, which we are so excited for. We're sure we will play lots of fun games! We will also be continuing our regular yoga practise.

Music

Our weekly Charanga session will be entitled 'Imitation'. Pupils will be joining in with singing in their own way and working on listening to and imitating aspects of a range of pieces of music.
