We will explore each text through a range of learning through play and adult led activities.</p> <p>Please see our reading newsletter for information about our Author of the Month.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>In Maths this half term we will be focusing on counting, sequencing and ordering numbers using counting songs and a range of activities.</p> <p>We will be exploring measure and capacity, emptying and filling different sized containers and experiencing objects of different weight and size. We will use a range of objects to fill our containers including, sticks, pebbles, sand and water.</p>	<p><b>Understanding The World</b></p> <p>In Understanding of the World, our topic will be “In the Garden”. We will be growing vegetables and fruit from seed and roleplaying garden centres.</p> <p>We will be learning about how plants, seeds and flowers change over time.</p> <p>We will be exploring the fruit to make fruit salads and showing our preferences.</p> <p>Green class will be exploring cause and effect toys, focussing on push, pull and twist.</p> <p>We will be exploring different cultural events as they happen in RE.</p>
